ADAM AND EVE

Story of creation and man's fall

Key Texts: Genesis 1, 2, and 3

God created the heavens, the earth, and everything on the earth. Lastly, God created the first man, Adam, and placed him in Eden, a special garden. A heavenly being teaches Adam about God's plan for his life as the Prince of the World. The being also leads Adam to the center of the garden and tells him about the Tree of Life and the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. As he explores the garden, Adam notices two of every kind of creature, except for himself. Then, God puts Adam to sleep and creates a woman from one of Adam's ribs. Adam shows Eve around the garden and explains that they must not eat of the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. One day, Eve wanders from Adam's side and admires the forbidden fruit on the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. A serpent speaks to her from the branches and Eve eats some of the fruit. Then she brings some to Adam and he eats it, too. Because of Adam's and Eve's decisions, sin enters the world and the Serpent becomes its Prince. For the first time, Adam and Eve experience fear and sadness. They have to leave the garden because of their sin, but before departing they learn about God's plan of salvation.

Main Characters

God—Creator of the World

Adam—Son of God; first man created

Eve—Daughter of God; first woman created

A heavenly being who shows Adam around the garden*

The Serpent—The Tempter; the Enemy

Other Character Mentioned

Son of God who will be born to save the world
